ESTABLISHMENT OF CAPACITY BUILDING CENTRES AS A SUSTAINABLE SOLUTION TO RAISE THE STANDARDS OF TEACHING STAFF IN INDIAN HEIS

APPLICATIONS INVITED FOR TRAIN-THE-TRAINER PROGRAM

Overview

CABCIN is a European Union funded project under the Erasmus+ Programme consisting of European and Indian Universities. The aim of this project is to establish Capacity Building Centres at five Indian Universities with assistance from five European Universities and the grant received from European Union. Various training programs & activities would be conducted by the European Universities for the faculty members of Indian Universities.

RK University is one of the selected five Indian Universities. Over the period of next two years, the process of training faculty members & establishment of the Capacity Building Centre would take place. The first activity that will be carried out is "Train the Trainers", under which five trainers from RK University will be selected and trained by the European Partner Universities. This activity would have various modules such as designing E-Learning courses, developing curriculum for Higher Education, implementing interactive instructional strategies in higher education and soft skills in higher education.

Responsibilities of the selected Trainers:

Trainer working in the Capacity Building Centre will be responsible for supporting academics development focused on pedagogical skills with ICT support by delivery of trainings (face to face and e-learning).

Trainer in the Capacity Building Centre:

- (will design and conduct a variety of trainings, workshops, on-line courses for teaching staff who wish to practice effective teaching strategies and enhance student learning
- (will be the main source of building teaching culture between academic society, promoting joint problem solving and interaction among professors, as well developing teaching skills
- (will be the basic source for delivering services, communication and teaching on-line materials
- (will conduct needs analysis to identify areas of improvement, design and conduct evaluation of developed trainings/ curriculum
- (will develop the strategy of the center with university authorities according to identified needs.

The trainer will participate in the professional Train-the-Trainer program November 2017 – February 2018 with evaluation at the end.
